Subject: Expert Advisory Committee on IT infra-structure for Inter-Institute networking and on Health Management Information System (HMIS) within each Institute of National Importance

1. 2. Terms of Reference of the Committee are as follows:

- To take into account the experience of Institutions of National Importance on their existing IT infrastructure and HMIS.
 - To take into account the scope of making full utilization of National Knowledge Network.
 - To take into account the existing provisions on IT infrastructure and HMIS in new AIIMS works packages.
 - To take into account the state of the art infrastructure, facilities and systems on IT infrastructure and HMIS.
 - To recommend a framework for setting up of robust HMIS facilities and IT infrastructure for the Institutes of National Importance including the new AIIMS and their inter-connectivity considering budgetary requirements and sustainability of operations.
 - To recommend draft RFP to be considered by MoHFW for implementation under PMSSY.
3. The Committee will submit its recommendations to MoHFW within a period of two months. The Committee may co-opt any other person/organization as Member depending upon requirement. Expenditure on functioning of the Committee shall be met out of Grant in Aid available with AIIMS, Jodhpur, with the concurrence of FA, AIIMS, Jodhpur.
