Minutes of the 42nd Meeting of the Project Monitoring Committee of PMSSY under the chairmanship of AS (H) held at 01:15 PM on 02nd February, 2017 at Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi

- 1. The 42nd meeting of the Project Monitoring Committee of PMSSY was held at 01:15 PM on 02 February, 2017 at Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi. Agenda had been circulated among the Members well in advance. The List of the participants is placed at Annexure. In the absence of Secretary (HFW), AS (H) chaired the meeting.
- 2. AS (H) welcomed the participants and asked Joint Secretary (PMSSY) to start the proceedings as per agenda circulated. Joint Secretary (PMSSY) started the proceedings and drew the attention to the agenda.
- 3. The State-wise discussions and decisions taken by the PMC are as follows:
 - i. Andhra Pradesh
 - a) <u>AIIMS at Mangalagiri</u>
 - Representatives from State Govt. of Andhra Pradesh joined the meeting through Video conferencing.
 - They informed that boundary wall demarcation and decision on front side of the campus will be done within 45 days.
 - Regarding the issue of early start of Institute, it was decided that the hospital at Tenali has been identified and inspected by Central team. The State Govt. was requested to identify other required infrastructure like hostels, faculty residences, etc. so that further action would be taken for starting AIIMS in A.P. from 2018-19.
 - b) Upgradation of Siddhartha Medical College, Vijaywada
 - It was informed by the State Govt. representatives that demolition/shifting of DG pump room, electrical panel room and underground water tank has been completed.
 - Shifting of sceptic tank and clearances from Municipalities will be expedited by the State Govt.

ii. Assam

- a) AIIMS at Village Jalah
- It was informed by the representative of Govt. of Assam that the next hearing of NGT stay is on 07.02.2017.
- AS (H) asked the State Govt. to submit the timelines to fulfill the commitments on 33/11 KV electricity line, provision of 5 MLD water,

shifting of over-head cables, 4-lane connectivity to the site and earth filling of the site within one week.

- b) <u>Upgradation of Assam Medical College</u>, Dibrugarh
- It was informed that work has started and dismantling of existing buildings will be done within 15 days & removal of electrical lines will be done within 07 days.

iii. Goa

- a) <u>Upgradation of Government Medical College, Panaji</u>
- It was informed by the representative of the State Govt. that the next hearing for the Court stay is on 13.02.17 and the clearances from local bodies will be sought after the stay is vacated.

iv. Gujarat

- a) Upgradation of Government Medical College, Rajkot
- It was informed by the representative of the State Govt. that the demolitions at the site is in progress and will be completed within 15 days.
- b) <u>Upgradation of Government Medical College, Surat and Government</u> <u>Medical College, Bhavnagar</u>
- The State Govt. representative was advised that the revised requirements of the GMCs may be submitted within 7 days so that the Gap Analysis report could be finalized.

v. Jammu & Kashmir

- a) AIIMS in Jammu & AIIMS in Kashmir
- Secretary (Health), Govt. of J&K, attended meeting through video conferencing. He informed that the State Govt. is not considering early start of first session of Medical College of AIIMS in temporary campus. The State Govt. wants that the MBBS courses be started in the new AIIMS once the infrastructure get created on the allotted sites.
- All the encroachments will be removed and all commitments will be fulfilled within 45-60 days.
- CPWD was advised to initiate the process for appointment of Design Consultant. The consultancy work may, however, be awarded only after the approval of the project by the cabinet.
- Barbed wire fencing may be done for demarcation of the Boundary of the site and this activity may be undertaken immediately.

vi. Kerala

a) <u>Upgradation of Kozhikode Medical College and T.D. Medical College</u>, <u>Alappuzha</u>

• It was informed by the representatives of State Govt. that the commitment from the State Govt. for additional scope of work will be provided for which the matter is under process for approval by State cabinet which is likely by the end of this month.

vii. Maharashtra

- a) <u>AIIMS in Nagpur</u>
- The facilities at GMC, Nagpur have been offered by the State Government and needs to be inspected by the technical team of the Ministry so that the gaps are filled before start of MBBS session from 2018-19. It was discussed that the early start of the institute from 2017-18 is not feasible as not much time is left to provide needed infrastructure and recruit the faculty.
- b) <u>Upgradation of 4 Medical Colleges under Phase-III of PMSSY</u>
- All issues have already been resolved and all the projects are in progress.

viii. Punjab

- a) Upgradation of Government Medical College, Patiala
- Representative of the State Govt. informed that the site has been cleared and only the environmental clearances and approvals from local body are pending which will be obtained quickly.
- b) Upgradation of Government Medical College, Amritsar under Phase-II
- It was brought to notice by the representative of the State Govt. that the diagnostic block has not been taken over by the State PWD as there are some issues/deficiencies to be resolved by the executing agency i.e., HSCC.
- HSCC was advised to resolve the issues quickly and hand over the assets to the state.

ix. Uttar Pradesh

- a) <u>AIIMS at Gorakhpur</u>
 - As informed by Representative of Government of UP, the transfer of land from Sugarcane Department to Medical Education Department of Government of UP has been done.
 - Further, the State Government has intimated that the process for change of land use would also be likely to be completed by 10th February, 2017. Once the land use has been changed, the land will be transferred to MoHFW, Government of India.
- b) AIIMS at Rae Bareli
 - The State Govt. was requested to provide security for created infrastructure at AIIMS Rae Bareli.

- c) <u>Upgradation of Government Medical College</u>, Agra and Government <u>Medical College</u>, Kanpur
 - State Govt. was requested to provide commitment for bearing the share of cost of Rs.80 crore each for the upgradation of GMC Agra and GMC, Kanpur.
- d) Upgradation of Government Medical Colleges under Phase-III
 - CPWD informed that there are no pending issues with Govt. Medical College, Gorakhpur and LLR Medical College, Meerut.
 - 25% work at Govt. Medical College, Gorakhpur has been done and the project will be completed by October, 2017.
 - 42% work at LLR Medical College, Meerut has been done and the project will be completed by November, 2017.
 - Electrical lines at MLN Medical College, Allahabad have been removed and there are no pending issues.
- 4. All the representatives of the States were requested to initiate the recruitment process and submit the recruitment calendar for HR to this Ministry within 15 days. It was advised to ensure recruitment of HR well in time so that infrastructure created in up-gradation of GMC can be made functional and services started with completion of construction project.
- 5. The Meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the Chair.
