**Subject: Standing Selection Committee Meeting quorum-reg.**


I am directed to say that vide Circular No.01 PMSSY-May 2015 dated 01<sup>st</sup> May, 2015, instructions were issued regarding re-constitution and procedure of Selection Committees for selection of faculty, non-faculty residents and contractual posts etc. in new AIIMS. It was, inter-alia, communicated that at least 50 per cent of the members present, besides the chairman, would constitute the quorum for the Standing Selection Committee.

2. In this connection, it may be noted that regulation 12, sub-regulation(6) of AIIMS Regulations, as amended from time to time, provides as follows:

*"50% of the members shall form the quorum for all Standing Committees. Members can also participate in the meeting through video conference, after obtaining the prior approval of the Chairman and such participation through video conference will be counted for the purpose of the quorum. In the case of Standing Selection Committee, the two experts would also be counted for purpose of determining the quorum."*

3. Thus, in suppression of all earlier guidelines in this regard, all new AIIMS are to follow the above regulation. Hence, 50% of the members shall form the quorum for all Standing Committees and the two subject experts would be counted for the purpose of determining the quorum of Standing Selection Committee meetings.
