Sub: Filling up of vacant Faculty posts on deputation basis in six new AIIMS


Dear Madam/Sir,

The matter regarding filling up of vacant Faculty posts in various disciplines in the six new AIIMS has been under consideration in the Ministry. Based on the recommendations of the High Powered Committee, it has now been decided to allow filling up of vacant Faculty posts on deputation basis in the six new Institutes, in the event direct recruitment fails.

2. Faculty drawn from Institutes of National Importance (INIs) and Government Medical Colleges (GMCs) may be given this opportunity to work on deputation in the new AIIMS. The deputation appointments may be made initially for five years, extendable for another two years. Terms of deputation would be regulated in accordance with the relevant guidelines outlining various aspects of deputation as issued by Department of Personnel & Training vide their OMs No. 6/8/2009-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 17th June, 2010, OM No. 2/6/2016-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 17th February, 2016 and OM No. 2/6/2016-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 23rd February, 2017.

3. The new AIIMS may initiate action to fill up those vacant Faculty posts on deputation basis where direct recruitment has failed. The matter may be placed before respective GBs/IBs of the Institutes for approval/ratification in due course.
